

TELECOMMUNICATIONS EDUCATION SPONSORSHIP

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Selected students agree to complete the 2-year NCK Tech program located in Hays, KS and earn an Associate of Applied Science Degree in Telecommunications. Upon completion of the program and the required Pioneer summer internships, he or she agree to become an employee of Pioneer Communications for a minimum of 3 years (or 4 years with housing allowance) in the following departments:

- Engineering
- Field Operations
- Information Technology
- Or other dept's determined by Pioneer Communications

3-year employment commitment = NO housing allowance

4-year employment commitment = YES housing allowance

RECRUITMENT

Students will complete an application and be interviewed by Pioneer Communication staff for admittance to the program. Consideration will be given for those currently enrolled at NCK Tech or to recent high school graduates.

COST

The sponsorship includes the student's required tuition, books, fees and tools, if applicable, for the duration of the 2-year program. 2022-2023 tuition rates:

HOUSING ALLOWANCE

Pioneer Communications offers an allowance towards on- or off-campus housing for students who agree to FOUR YEARS of employment with Pioneer Communications. On-campus housing rates, as well as rental rates in the local market, will be evaluated. If the student's housing is already covered by other funding sources (scholarships, grants, etc.) or he/she resides with family members, no housing allowance is provided. Following graduation from NCK Tech, he or she will no longer be eligible for a housing allowance.



EARLY WITHDRAWAL & FORFEITURE

If student withdraws or discontinues from NCK Tech's program for any reason prior to graduation or elects to not become employed by Pioneer Communications, the student forfeits the sponsorship agreement and must reimburse Pioneer Communications for 100% of paid tuition, books, and tools.
